A brief history of archetypal themes in film will be followed by a discussion of different perspectives on the interpretation of film. This gorgeous romantic fantasy is filled with archetypal themes and characters who are outsiders, the other, who are different and lonely. The director, Guillermo del Toro explores these themes through intensely fantastical and imaginative images. We will view the film in the morning, which will be followed by an afternoon discussion. Two CGJIC Jungian Analysts, John Todd and Nancy Ortenberg, will explore the film's archetypal and social themes as seen in the many faces of beauty, humanity, ugliness and evil.
